If your child wishes to change from school dinners to packed lunches or vice versa, please be reminded that we need two weeks' notice at the school office.

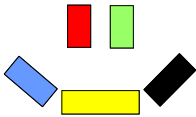

Suits on the Streets Fundraising

On Thursday 9th October Oliver Storey from Eagles class will be sleeping rough on the streets of Bradford to raise awareness and money for the work of **Inn Churches** – a charity that helps provide shelter for the homeless during the cold winter months.

Inn Churches work with over 550 volunteers from 70 churches and the wider community and using available spaces in local churches have provided over 5,000 beds for homeless and vulnerable people in the Bradford area since they started in 2010.

It costs just under £10 per person to provide an evening meal, a warm bed and a hearty breakfast.
