


- 1. Assessment: Be consistent with an assessment procedure so that it is fully understood and supports teaching and learning.

Defibrillator - thanks to the community's fantastic efforts, the village defibrillator is now live! Instead of being in the community rooms, it has been placed in the Shoulder of Mutton (much easier to locate). A training event is due to take place on 25th October at 7pm for anyone wishing to gain further information, but if there is an emergency contact 999 and they can provide full instructions.

Bikeability - Monday, 10th and Tuesday, 11th October 2016 - For those pupils taking part in the bikeability programme this is just a reminder that the course takes place next Monday and Tuesday. (letters have been issued to those eligible) Children must have their bikes and helmets in School on both days. Children are not required to wear school uniform on these days but the instructors do ask that pupils wear sensible warm clothing for cycling (ie not baggy joggers) and do recommend gloves and a waterproof coat as the course does go ahead unless they feel the weather makes the course unsafe.
