<u>School Office –</u> We welcome\_Mrs Maltby who has now joined our admin team and will be based in the front office three mornings per week. Please feel free to pop in and say 'hello'!

<u>School Dinner Payments – Parentpay</u> the amount owing for school dinners for this next half term is £62.35 (29 days @ £2.15 per day). If your child only has meals on certain days, the amounts owing are as follows: 1 meal per week £12.90, 2 meals per week £25.80, 3 meals per week £38.70, 4 meals per week £51.60. If your child has a

dinner on a Monday, please remember to deduct £2.15 from the amount owing as we are closed on Monday, 4<sup>th</sup> January 2016.

If you haven't already done so, please ensure payment is made before Monday to ensure your child continues to receive dinners. When making payment, please ensure you take into account any credits or debits on your parentpay account. Should you have any queries regarding payments, please do not hesitate to contact the office.

Taking and using videos and photographs at Kirk Smeaton C of E School – If you haven't already done so, please return the form at your earliest convenience, ensuring you sign and tick in the appropriate place on the form. Also, please ensure when taking any photographs that no members of staff or other adults are included in the background of the photograph.



Complete Sport – Multi Skills After School Club – This club commenced on Thursday and was offered for either one hour or two hours. Due to lack of interest for the two hour session this club will now only run for 1 hour (3.30-4.30pm). Any payment enquires should be discussed directly with the after school provider, Coach Clayton.

<u>Swimming Lessons</u> The government is committed to ensuring swimming takes place in schools. Swimming is a compulsory part of the current national curriculum for PE. By the end of key stage 2 (age 11), pupils should be taught to swim unaided for a distance of at least 25 meters, using recognised strokes, on their front and back, and demonstrate an understanding of water safety. It is up to primary schools to decide when, and at what point they wish to teach this.

All children in year 3 will have eighteen 1 hour swimming lessons commencing on Friday, 26th February 2016 (2-3pm). This change will ensure that when each child leaves our school they will be able to swim 25metres unaided. The pool hire and swimming instructor costs are covered by the school but unfortunately we do need to ask for transport payments. A minibus has been arranged to transport children to and from the event. The total cost for the eighteen trips is £45. This payment item has now been set up on parentpay. By making payment on parentpay you are also giving permission for your child to attend the lessons. We do ask that payment be made by Monday, 22nd February 2016. We understand this is short notice and should you need to extend this deadline, please speak in confidence to the school office.

Long Hair - If your child has long hair please ensure it is tied back for school. Also, we do remind parents to be vigilant for head lice.

<u>Coats! –</u> There are a number of children without coats in school. Wherever possible we do encourage outdoor play unless we have torrential downpours or we feel the weather makes playtime unsafe. With this in mind, please ensure your child has a warm winter coat in school.
