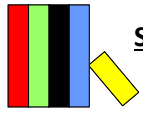

Bikeability-We now have all the consent forms for the pupils taking part in the bikeability. Your child will also have brought home a 'Tales of the Road' Highway Code theory booklet to revise. A short test

Parents & Friends – Fashion Show

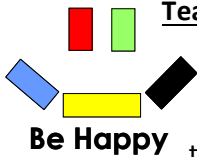
