Risk Assessment – our risk assessment has been updated and is attached to the newsletter. Please have a good read through it – new items are highlighted.

Illness or symptoms of COVID- If your child is under the weather or is showing symptoms of COVID, please follow the guidance on our website. Please contact school if you need to discuss any symptoms and we are happy to assist. If your child is off school while awaiting a test, please let us know if a test has been administered and where you are in receiving results. Children can access work from Oakwood national academy, we ask that children access this from the day they are off and additional class work maybe given if needed, please send completed work to the class teacher either through dojos for Lions and Dolphins, tapestry for Starfish and the admin email for Eagles. Please send work to us daily so we can give feedback.


