

Dear Parents/Carers

We hope all our families had lovely week off. It is lovely to see all the children back safe and happy. Next week our target will be to stay safe in the sun. Sports Day - we will be having our sports day on Tuesday 14th June (weather permitting), so please remember to send your children with P.E. kits, trainers, suncream, sunhats **Be Informed** and plenty of water. Dolphins, Lions and Eagles will be starting at 1pm and then at 2:30pm Starfish will be coming out to join them until 3:15pm. Parents are welcome to come and cheer them on, and we hope to see you all there! At the event all donations will be towards the cost of a defibrillator for the Smeaton community. There will be tea, coffee and some small crafts for sale. On Wednesday we had an ambulance and a demonstration of the defibrillator to all children and staff, it was an amazing day. Thank you to the Yorkshire Ambulance Service for providing this opportunity for our school.


<u>Presents</u>-Fathers Day is fast approaching! We have some gifts available for £3 from the front office, children are welcome to come and choose a gift during the day.

Football Festival - we will be taking teams from Years 2, 3 and 4 to Campsmount on Monday 13th June to compete in a football festival. Dolphins will now be competing in the afternoon, leaving after lunch and returning for 3:30pm. Lions will now be competing in the morning and return in time for lunch, so please make sure they are at school before the bus departs at 8:50. All children can wear the school football kit but please remember to bring a pair of trainers, shinpads and plenty of water. If you haven't already done so please make sure payment and consent are given on parent pay, or by email if you are having difficulties.

Next year arrangements-We are always looking for ways to develop learning within the school and whilst we are limited about the physical changes we can make because of the size of the building, we feel that there are some small changes we can make to our class structure to ensure that the youngest of our children, and any prospective pupils, get the best possible start. From October 2016 we want to provide an afternoon nursery in school to support the local morning nursery provided by Mrs Beck and offer parents with additional childcare support. We believe that bringing nursery children into the Starfish classroom will provide a really solid start for all

children starting at the school. So we can achieve this, in the coming year Year I and Year 2 will

be based in the current Dolphins classroom and throughout the day they will have access Starfish resources this is to support the transition into Key stage I and 2. To allow us to achieve this next year the classes will be structured in the following way: Y5/6 in Eagles classroom taught by Mrs Hursthouse and Miss Freeman Y3/4 in Lions classroom taught by Miss Ghent YI/2 in Dolphins classroom taught by Miss Pounder Reception and nursery in Starfish classroom taught by Ms Wolff and Mrs Morton



Askern Cricket - a reminder to all Dolphin parents that on Wednesday 15th June the class will be taking a trip to Askern Welfare Cricket Club to compete in the kwik cricket festival. They will need to be at school for 8:30 for registration. Please refer to your letter for further details or contact us if you have any queries.

If there are any changes to transport times we will let you know on the day, though we do not expect it to cause any disruptions to normal pick-up times. All children going on the trip need to come with sun cream, sun hats, raincoat and PE kit plus plenty of water.

Race for Life - the school will be hosting a race for life event on Thursday 7th July. Starfish and Dolphins will be running from 2pm, and Lions and Eagles from 2:30pm. Parents and children are all welcome to take part in the event, and we will attempt to run/walk 30 laps of the playground, which is 3 miles. Children will need a water bottle and PE kit for the day. Parents and friends will be serving refreshments - we hope to see you all there.
