<u>Robinwood Transport</u> Unfortunately, there are fewer children attending the Residential visits this year and this has had an impact on the cost of the transport. We have contacted several coach companies for the best price and the company we used last year have agreed not to increase the fee.

The cost of the Coach per child is £30, however 25% of the cost has been subsidised by the generosity of Parents & Friends. The reduced cost is £20. The transport fee has been set up on Parentpay. We have set the due date to Friday 16<sup>th</sup> October for both Lions and Eagles visits, to give everyone the same amount of time to pay.

Reception / Year 1 Numicon Homework Bags At the Reception meeting held on our transition day, it was recommended that children have access to a Numicon Homework Bag. Some Children in Year 1 already have these and these can be shared with siblings. If you would like to know more about these, please speak to Miss Wolff.
