**Class Photographs** – Confirmation of this will follow but we intend to have class photographs (including year 6 photographs) taken in the summer term.

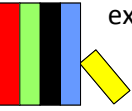


1. Leadership: Further develop middle leader's impact by sharing outstanding practice.

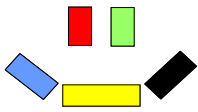
