<u>Year 6-</u> Well done to all our Year 6's after their week of SAT's. You were all fantastic and we're so proud of each of you.

<u>Being organised-</u> we ask that all children bring their PE kits to school each week and to bring water bottles in to school daily and complete their homework each week.
