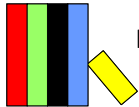
Dear parents/carers

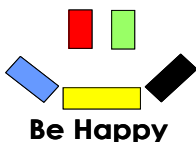
home alone) sign and return the appropriate page. If you do not have access to a printer, we do have blank copies you can collect from the school office.
