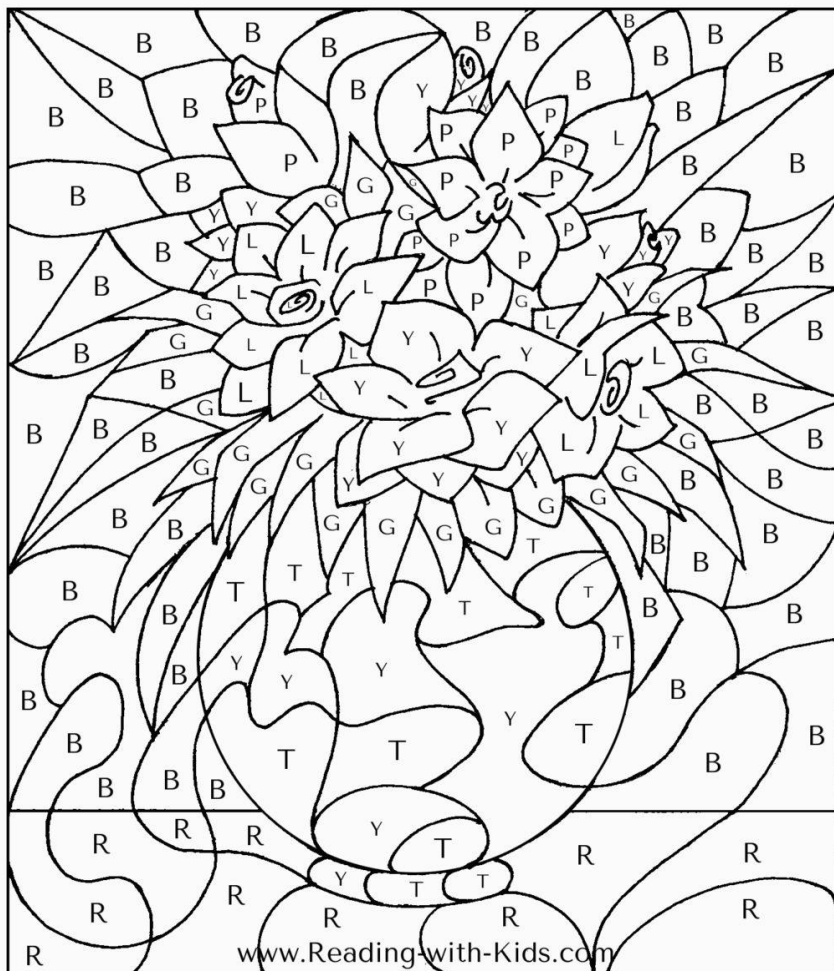

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Recipes

5 A Day Veggie Pasta

Ingredients (serves 5)

50g red lentils
240ml water
50g onions
1g garlic puree
1tbsp veg oil
4g tomato puree
380g chopped tomatoes
100g carrots
50g courgettes
50g grated red cheddar
½ red pepper
1g mixed herbs
200g penne pasta

- * Cook the lentils in water for 15-20 mins until tender.
- * Fry the onions and garlic puree in oil
- * Add the chopped tomatoes, tomato puree and vegetables, simmering until the veg has softened
- * Cook the pasta as per the packet instructions, then drain and rinse in boiling water
- * Combine everything together and serve topped with cheese

Banana Muffins

Ingredients (serves 12)

240g bananas
180g plain flour
60g wholemeal flour
6g baking powder
60g granulated sugar
1 medium egg
200ml semi-skimmed milk
60ml veg oil
30g pumpkin seeds

- * Mash the bananas
- * Mix the dry ingredients together
- * Beat in the eggs, milk and oil
- * Fold in the bananas
- * Spoon the mixture into bun cases and sprinkle the seeds over
- * Bake in a moderate oven for 10-15 mins
