

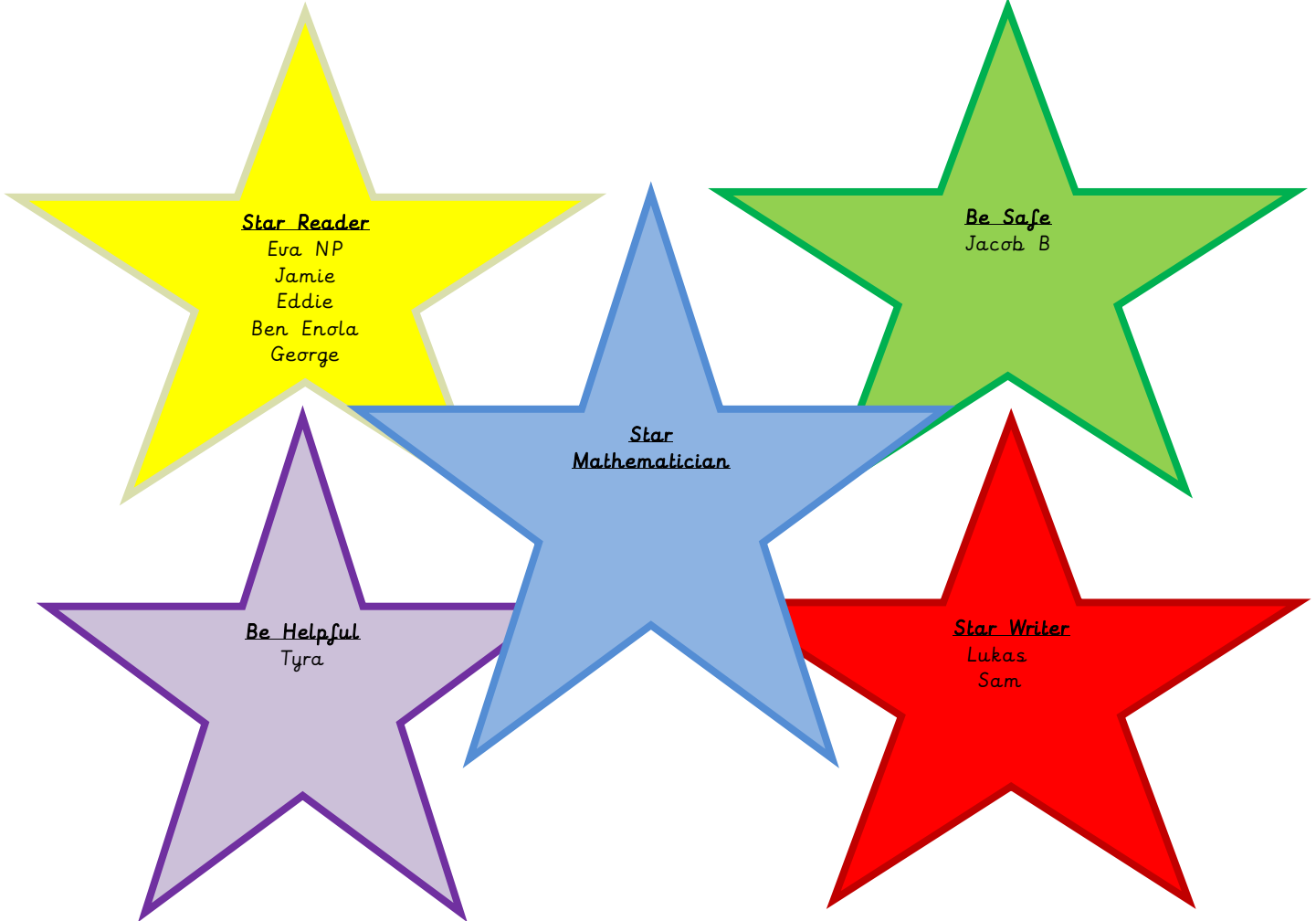

Can we please ask you to remind your children that if accessing the school grounds during the summer holidays that they do so with care and respect. Anyone accessing the site during the holidays do so at their own risk.

Flu Vaccine – Please see attached the letter, which has been sent to parents whose children will be in Reception to Year 5 from September 2018

The letter is to give consent for your child to receive the Flu Vaccine on the Morning of the 02nd October 2018. The consent can ONLY be given online following the instructions on the letter, consent cannot be accepted at the school office or to teachers, and it has to be done using the link on the letter. Please read the attached and action as soon as possible

School Meals - September 2018 - As a reminder the new school meal price from September 2018 is £2.50 per day. All children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 in September will continue to receive universal free school meals.

The amount due for the first half term in September (5th September 2018 - 26th October 2018) is £92.50.

If your child only has meals on certain days please remember the new daily amount is £2.50 and the first half term is 7 weeks and three days (Wednesday, Thursday and Friday).

Please ensure payment is made onto parentpay by Friday, 31st August 2018.
