- Breakfast club changes- Thank you to parents who have shared feedback on the breakfast club. We have made some changes. We now have Mrs Helstrip, the kitchen cook, as a breakfast club worker on an ad hoc basis. We are asking for parents to let us know if they are unable to secure a place a week in advance and we will look to deploy Mrs Helstrip or another member of staff into the breakfast club so we can take additional children. Parents and carers also asked for the breakfast club to open from 7.30am, we are now able to facilitate this, so the change will take place from Monday 3<sup>rd</sup> June 24. After carefully assessing the cost of running the breakfast club in relation to staff wages, we have made an adjustment in the cost of the provision from £5 to £6, this change will take affect from Monday 3<sup>rd</sup> June 24.
