

## **Parent Consultations**

Our March consultations will be available to book on Arbor from 1<sup>st</sup> February at 8am. If you child is on a target plan you will not need to book a slot, but teachers will instead contact you to arrange a separate meeting.

## **Wrap Around Care**

When booking our breakfast and after school clubs, please be reminded of the following points:

- As we have Nursery accessing wraparound care, we legally can't have more than 8 children within the club. We suggest that you pre-book in advance and let us know a week in advance if you are unable book all your children in to the club. We may, depending on numbers, look to add another member of staff the club if permitted.
- There is no after school club on a Monday.
- Our after school club closes promptly at 5:30 Tuesday-Thursday, and 5:00 on Fridays.
- Breakfast club is open from 7:45 each morning. Access cannot be gained before this time.
- Bookings can be made up to 24 hours before the club starts on Arbor payment must be made in advance.
- To cancel after school club with no charge, please let the school office know by 9am on the day.
- To cancel breakfast club with no charge, please let the school office know by 1pm the day before.
- As we can take children as young as 3, legally we can only have 8 children in our clubs, unless parents and
  carers have spoken to school and we have been able to add an additional member of staff- this needs to be
  a least a week in advance. We will turn you away at the door if legally we don't have the staff or contact

# parents and carers at the end of the day to pick their child up. Please note that children who are left in school or at the school door will be reported as a social care concern.

- If your child has extra needs or is unable to self care ie. nappies, potty training, please speak to us at least 1 week before booking a space. For safeguarding purposes, we need to have 2 member of staff when supporting with intimate needs.
- Please double check your bookings to make sure these have gone through correctly and your place is secure.
