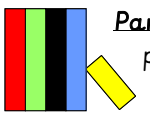
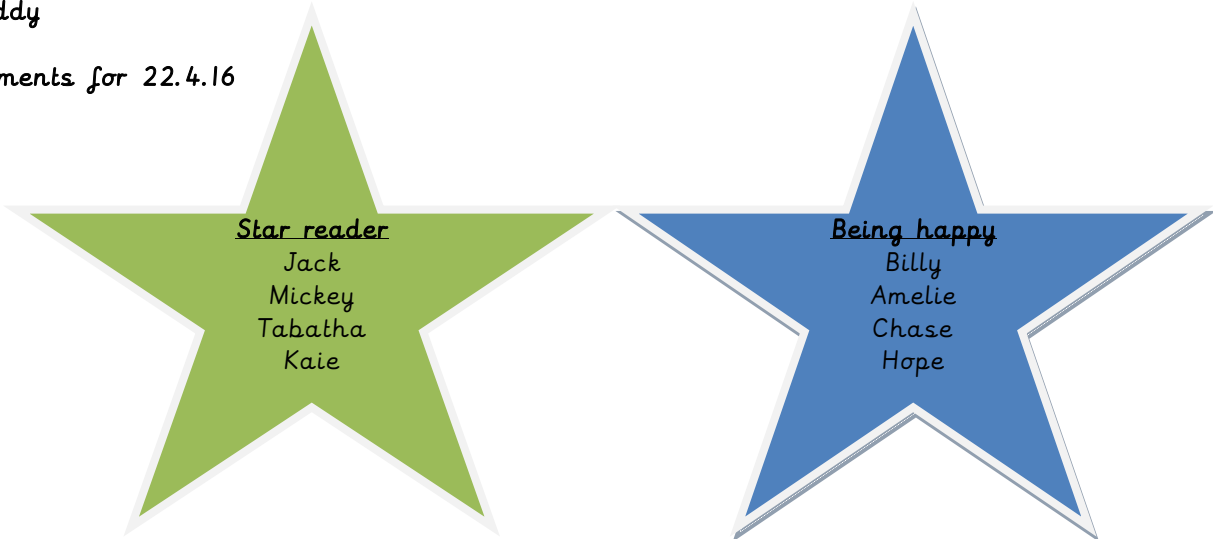

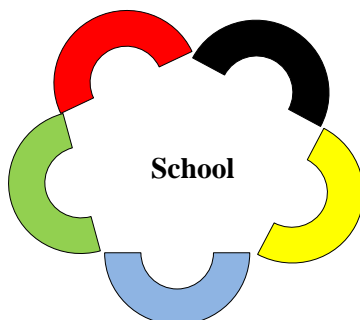

1. Leadership: Further develop middle leader's impact by sharing outstanding practice.

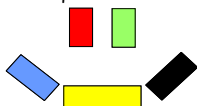
2. Challenge: Encourage challenge and mastery in Maths, Reading, Writing and SPAG for more able learners.
