Dear Lions Class and Parents/Carers,

For the maths, read through the slides for your year group. The plan is for your parent/carer to show them what we would be teaching and how so they can explain things to you. Then choose the work for your ability - A is the easiest and C is more difficult. Remember to challenge yourself but don't struggle on if you are finding it too difficult. If there are no answers provided it means that the work to be done will provide a variety of different answers so you will have to check the work you have done with very carefully - maybe with a calculator or ask an adult/older sibling for help.

Science and topic work is on Seneca and RE is on the website. Please choose one of these to do each day and don't forget to do some physical exercise or activity each day too. It is important to stay healthy and we would recommend Joe Wicks, Cosmic Kids yoga or anything else that gets you active.

In Science, our topic this term is Animals (including humans). On Seneca, you should find there is a Year 3 and a Year 4 version of this. Both of these need to be completed by all class members and we would recommend that you complete the Year 3 work before progressing onto the Year 4 work. Ideally, the Year 3 module should take you

up until the May half term holiday and in the final half term we will complete the Year 4 module.

For RE this half term we are going to be looking at what we can learn from religions about deciding what is right and wrong. There will be a new task each week on the website to complete. The first is a piece of artwork!
