Lions Visit to The Yorkshire County Cricket Club

Dear Parents,

Our theme this half term is the Olympics, and we will be looking at a range of physical activities, as well as thinking about how to keep fit and healthy. In order to enhance the children's learning around this subject, we would like to go on a trip to The Yorkshire County Cricket Club on Thursday 14th July. This trip will be useful when the children look at the benefits of physical activity and how the body functions when we exercise in science, as well as when the children write an instructional text on how to play a sport such as cricket.

We will be leaving school at 9:00am by coach and returning to school for 3:30pm. Children should wear comfortable clothing suitable for participating in physical activity (e.g. Tracksuit and trainers or equivalent, and a light coat. In the morning we will be given a 90 minute classroom session linking cricket to English, numeracy and Geography, followed by 90 minutes of cricket based activities. Following lunch there will then be a behind the scenes tour of Headingley Cricket Ground.

Those children who normally have a school dinner will be provided with a packed lunch consisting of a cheese sandwich (bread roll), ½ sausage roll, carrot and cucumber sticks, biscuits and grapes with a bottle of water. Please let us know if your child doesn't like cheese sandwiches. If your child normally brings a packed lunch but you would like us to prepare one on this occasion please let the school office know by Friday 24th June, and make a payment of £2.15 on parent pay. Please be reminded that packed lunches should not consist of fizzy drinks, sugary snacks or crisps etc.

If your child is taking medication on the day of the trip please clearly write their name on it and hand it to Miss Ghent. Please complete a prescription form in the office before the trip if possible otherwise we are unable to administer it.

The cost of the trip is £11.50 and this includes the entrance fee, workshop, activities and transport. (This is a voluntary contribution however we must stress that without the contribution, the trip would not be able to go ahead).
